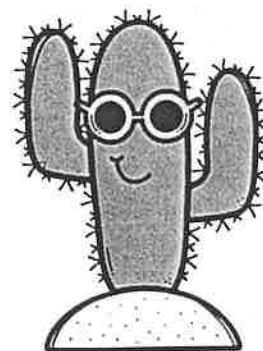

Students will work on addition, subtraction and counting forward/backwards. After a student completes 25 minutes of work for the day, they will log their work on the log provided or on a separate piece of lined paper. They will write down the date, math fact worked on for the day (addition, subtraction or counting forward/backwards), how many minutes they worked and get a parent signature.

Students will receive a raffle entry for every completed log. You can make additional copies of the log or use a sheet of paper to record more practice and earn extra entries for the raffle.

You can print the worksheets or have your child copy the problems onto a different sheet of paper. Make sure your child shows their work when completing.
